## RIGHT TO INFORMATION (REGULATION OF FEE AND COST) RULES, 2005

[NOTIFICATION NO. 34012/8(S)/2005-ESTT (B), DATED 16-9-2005]

In exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (b) and (c) of sub-section (2) of section 27 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Right to Information (Regulation of Fee and Cost) Rules. 2005.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. Definitions.
- 2. In the rules, unless the context otherwise requires, -
- (a) 'Act' means the Right to Information Act, 2005;
- (b) 'section' means section of the Act;
- (c) all other words and expressions used herein but not defined and defined in the Act shall have the meanings assigned to them in the Act.
- 3. A request for obtaining information under sub-section (1) of section 6 shall be accompanied by an application fee of rupees ten by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or bankers cheque [or Indian Postal Order] payable to the Accounts Officer of the public authority.
- 4. For providing the information under sub-section (1) of section 7, the fee shall be charged by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or bankers cheque <sub>1</sub>[or Indian Postal Order] payable to the Accounts Officer of the public authority at the following rates:.
- (a) rupees two for each page (in A4 or A3 size paper) created or copied;
- (b) actual charge or cost price of a copy in larger size paper;
- (c) actual cost or price for samples or models; and
- (d) 2[for inspection of records, no fee for the first hour; and a fee of rupees five for each subsequent hour (or fraction thereof)].
- 5. For providing the information under sub-section (5) of section 7, the fee shall be charged by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or bankers cheque <sup>3</sup>[or Indian Postal Order] payable to the Accounts Officer of the public authority at the following rates:.
- (a) for information provided in diskette or floppy rupees fifty per diskette or floppy; and
- (b) for information provided in printed form at the price fixed for such publication or rupees two per page of photocopy for extracts from the publication.
